



## Safe Haven for Donkeys

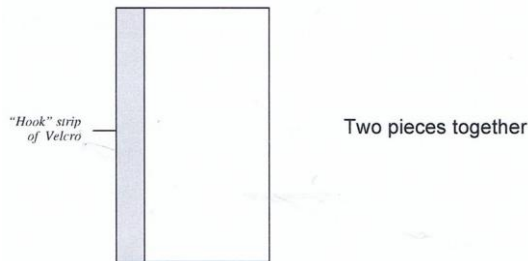
### Nose Chain Covers/Protectors

#### For each one you will need:

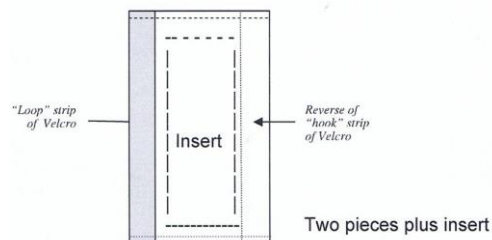
- Two pieces of thick material 9 inches by 6 inches (fake sheepskin or thick fleece is best but not fake fur as this tends to come apart). The thicker the better as it provides more protection to sore noses.
- An additional piece of this material 8 inches by 5 inches as a filler for extra thickness.
- 9 inches of Velcro 20 or 25 mm width (non-adhesive – the kind that comes in two parts “hook” and “loop”)

#### To make:

- Place both large pieces together at the long ends
- Then machine sew the “hook” strip of the Velcro onto the longest edge of the material



- Turn over the material and sew the “loop” strip of the Velcro onto the other longest edge (not onto the reverse of the Velcro you just sewed on)



- Now you will have a “tube” with open ends
- Insert the filler piece inside the “tube”
- Finally sew across the shorter ends of the material to prevent fraying (see dotted lines above)
- Then role the material into a tube – the two sides of Velcro should join together, making a cover that can easily be put on/taken off.
